West Dorset Wilding needs you! Are you a great salesperson and do you have an interest in nature? In which case you might be just who we are looking for. West Dorset Wilding (WDW), a local landowner-led nature conservation charity, is looking for a self-motivated, enthusiastic, energetic and professional individual to help us recruit corporate supporters for the charity.

We have recently set up a corporate sponsorship scheme to boost our fundraising and engage members of the local (West Dorset) business community with what we are doing. We need someone to make some calls, arrange some meetings, and generally persuade companies of the value of getting involved and being part of the solution.

We can offer an initial 8 days' work at £200/day for someone to undertake this work in March and April 2024, and if it goes well, there is great potential to continue the work into the future. The individual would be doing this in a self-employed capacity. They would need to take the initiative to contact businesses – and business groups – themselves, keep a record of all contacts and set up meetings for the charities' staff or Trustees to follow up if needed. WDW will give you training about the charity and our corporate sponsorship scheme, and also help with contacts.

Experience of corporate fundraising and working with charities would be helpful but not essential, likewise knowledge of nature conservation. **Energy, initiative, professionalism, organisation**, and the **ability to tell a compelling story** is what we are looking for here.
